

2009 mid-year estimates of population

The Office for National Statistics has published population estimates for mid 2009.

According to the estimates the population of Surrey was 1,113,100 on 30 June 2009. This is an increase of 12,400 since 2008.

The increase was due to natural change (births minus deaths) of 4,200, with net migration and other changes of 8,200.
