

# Camberley

**52% of the total Camberley area population can expect to wait approximately 10 minutes longer than they do now for a 2<sup>nd</sup> fire engine to arrive at night (18 minutes on average from receiving the 999 call)**

**48% of Camberley's emergency calls require MORE than 1 fire engine**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> closest fire engine for nearly a third of Camberley's population will be from Farnham taking on average 17 minutes to arrive at night. The 2<sup>nd</sup> closest fire engine for the rest of the population will be from Chobham taking on average 16 minutes to arrive but Chobham will be the 2<sup>nd</sup> closest fire engine for 90% of Woking's population following the planned cuts there.

Where will the fire engines come from to cover Farnham, Chobham and Woking whilst they are answering calls in Camberley? What if Chobham are already called to Woking? Who will cover Camberley then?
