

Cranleigh

100% of the total Cranleigh area population can expect to wait longer for a 1st and 2nd fire engine to arrive during the day and longer for the 2nd at night too

Cranleigh

(Population 10,270)

1st quickest fire engine during the day will be from Godalming but it will take 14 minutes longer than a Cranleigh fire engine could attend at present as the council propose to cut Cranleigh from 2 to 0 fire engines during the day. The second quickest on days would be from Guildford; 17 minutes slower. At night the 2nd quickest attendance will be from Dorking which will be 18 minutes slower as Cranleigh is proposed to be reduced to 1 fire engine at night.

Ewhurst

(Population 2,119)

1st quickest during the day will be from Dorking; 8 minutes slower and 2nd quickest from Godalming; 14 minutes slower. At night 2nd quickest will be from Dorking; 7 minutes slower.
