**Esher fire station is currently the for a population of 29,357.
On average those people will wait 8 minutes longer for a fire engine at night.**

Claygate, Hinchley Wood and Weston Green will get the worst emergency response times. 9 minutes slower during the days and 10 minutes slower at night.

Walton, Painshill and Sunbury fire stations will be the closest to answer the calls that Esher currently does. But that is assuming they are not answering calls in Walton. Painshill or Sunbury. Sunbury will also have to cover Staines at night too as a fire engine is being cut there too.

The largest population in Esher itself will wait 7 minutes longer for a fire engine at night.
